The good news is, the remedy is on its way! We will soon be installing a brand new four bay antenna. We are currently operating on one bay (shown in the picture above) of our old three bay antenna.

In addition to the new antenna, we will also be installing a new transmitter to better serve you! Please pray with us as the logistics of the installation can be challenging as we coordinate with the antenna manufacturer, shipping company, tower climbers, and engineers.

Thank you for your patience as we work through the details. We are committed to seeing WIVH, the Voice of Hope, continue to broadcast the good news of Gospel to the islands. We are also excited about what God will do as we continue to serve Him!
