It's imperative that the goal be reach as operating expenses for the upcoming year will be greater and more costs are developing as broadcasting problems are being resolved.

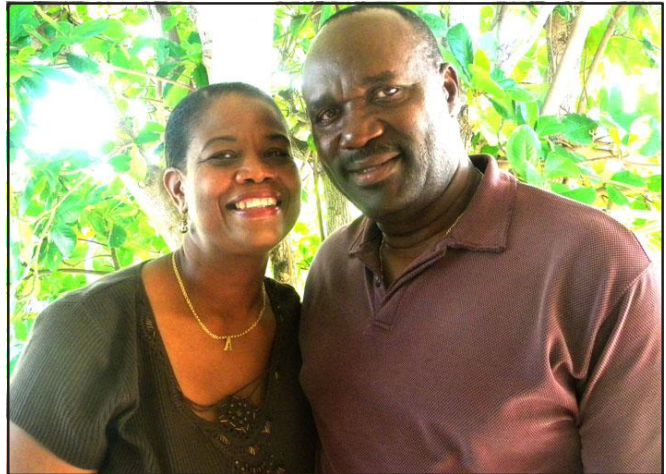

Reach Out Programs Compliment Broadcasting

WIVH has reach-out programs that complement its broadcasting and further enables the work of the Lord to reach those that may not be regular listeners. These are "Show Time," and "WIVH Correspondence School."

"Show Time," is conducted the first Saturday of each month when family-friendly films are shown on the studio grounds. Those attending are asked to bring along chairs or cushions. Pop corn and drink are free. The showing includes a short film for children and a full length film for the whole family.

"WIVH Correspondence School" is another service offered free of charge to those desiring to study God's Word. An extensive list of courses are being offered and are listed in a brochure. After making a selection, the study may be started by calling 718-2852. The course will be mailed to the enrollee and may be studied in the privacy of the home.
