A landmark event, "St. Croix's Community of Prayer," was held at Island Center recently. It is estimated that nearly 1000 residents were in attendance. The theme, "We Shall Overcome" was directed at individuals being challenged by economic uncertainty, during this time of the Hovensa refinery closing. Unity was expressed as powerful prayers spoke of healing and restoration. Emphasis was on the strengthening of marriages and families.
