

WRGN's Mission Possible Raises Funds for WIVH

Praise God from whom all blessings flow! On Friday, April 27, our sister station, WRGN, in Northeastern Pennsylvania set aside its regular programming and dedicated the day to raising funds for WIVH. They reached their goal of \$25,000 just after 7:15 pm and were

able to return to regular programming at 7:30 pm. Since then they have also raised another \$5,000!

Some of those funds will go towards the repair of the WIVH studios which lost a portion of its roof during last year's Hurricane Maria. Essential

broadcast equipment will also be repaired or replaced. Those pieces of equipment include a new 4-bay antenna and a new transmitter. The remaining funds raised will go towards the annual operating expenses of WIVH.

Danny's first trip to St. Croix was in March of this year when he evaluated the building and ordered the lumber and materials needed for repairs. Tim and Danny will be joined by Terry Daltroff, Wayne Morgan, Scott Pearson, and Alan Williams. Please keep these men in your prayers as they have much to accomplish in a short amount of time! The men will replace a large section of the roof that was damaged by Hurricane Maria last September. Other repairs to the porch roof will also be made.
