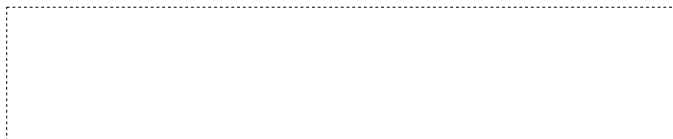
# Early Thanksgiving
